The mission of the Housing Services is to provide safe, modest, affordable housing to low income people in Hastings County.

Housing Services provides subsidized housing, rent supplement/housing allowances, and manages a centralized waiting list for all social housing in Hastings County (almost 2,600 units). They research and develop new affordable housing for residents of Hastings County. Tenants living in social housing pay about 30% of their income towards rent, or receive a flat rate supplement or allowance.
